Britain must not lose sight of its Christian roots — that was the message as construction officially began on the Eternal Wall of Answered Prayer.

Towering above the Angel of the North, the huge landmark will contain a million bricks, each telling a story of answered prayer. The structure will remind future generations of Britain's Christian heritage and bring hope for hundreds of years, said the project's visionary Richard Gamble at this week's groundbreaking ceremony.

Around 200 guests — including donors, civic leaders, pastors and long-standing supporters — gathered on site in Coleshill, near Birmingham, to witness the start of building work after the project reached its initial £40million fundraising target. Eternal Wall is anticipated to attract around 250,000 visitors a year once fully open in 2028. "This is a day I have prayed for, dreamed of and worked towards for 21 years," said Gamble.
